

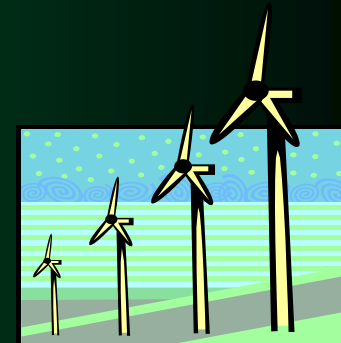

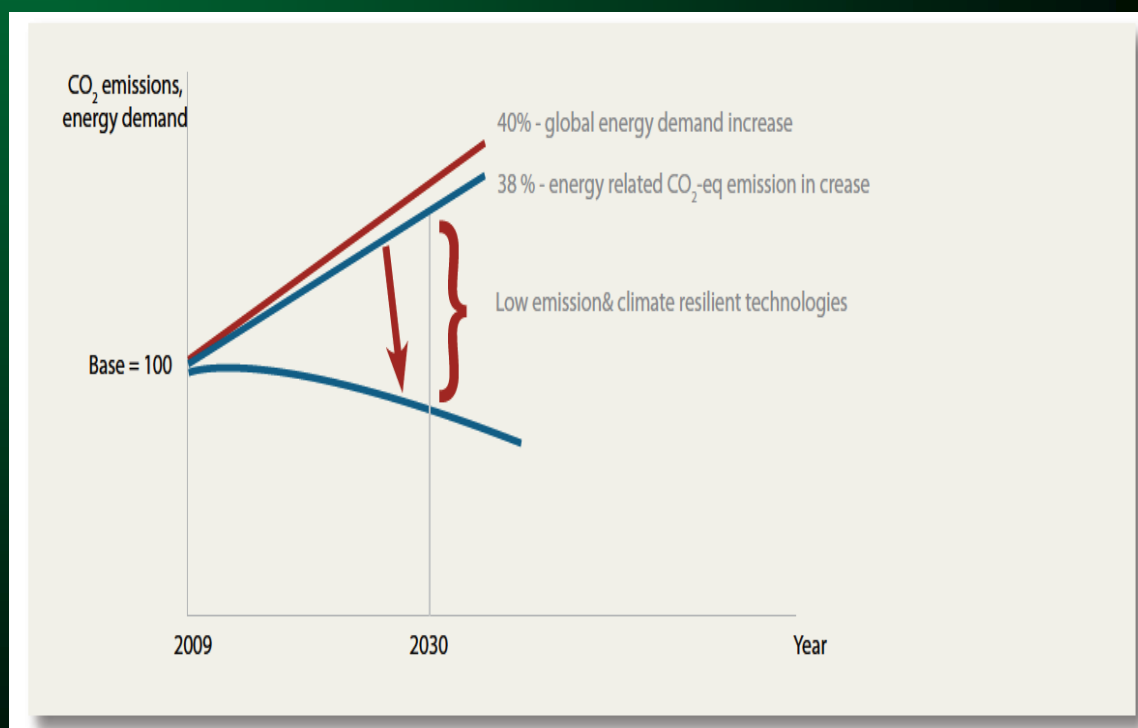

To address the impacts of climate change requires:

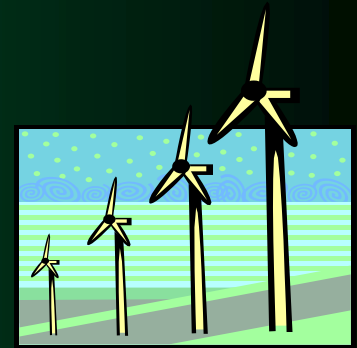
- ❑ Information by all sectors of society: government, private sector, by civil society and the citizenry

Role of CC Technologies in Realizing CC Goals





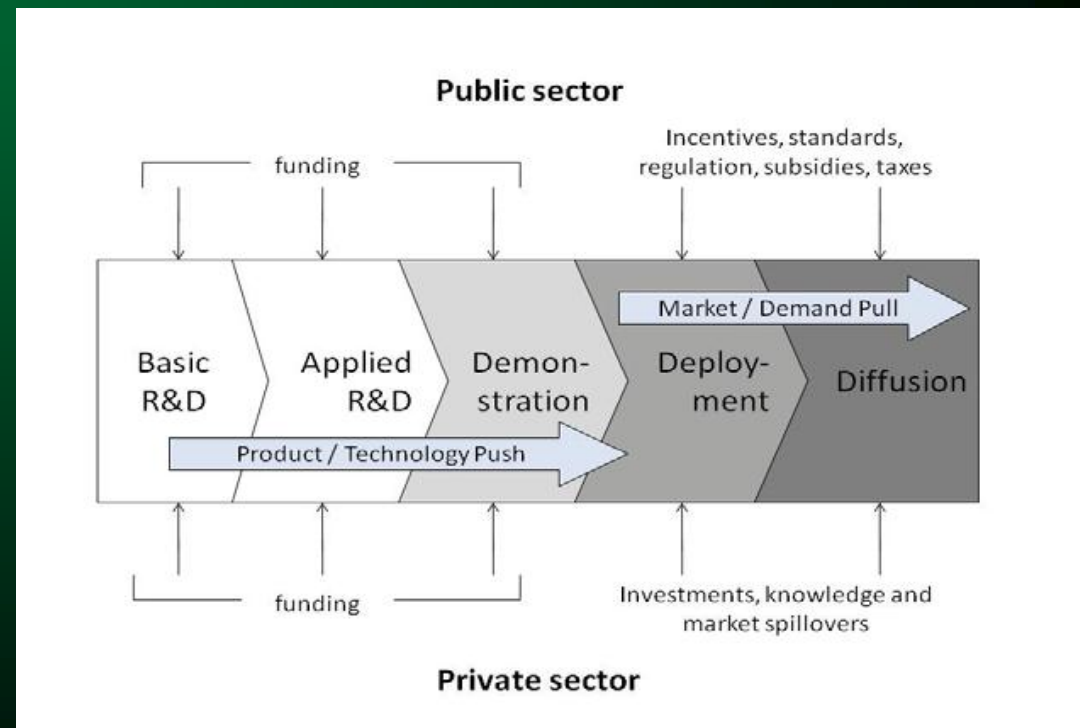

- ❑ Involve a combination of technology push and market pull interventions
- ❑ Private & Public Sectors involvement & cooperation

Capacity Development - UNDP Comparative Advantage

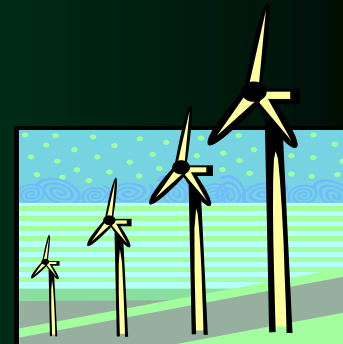
- ❑ Recognized and proven area of expertise.

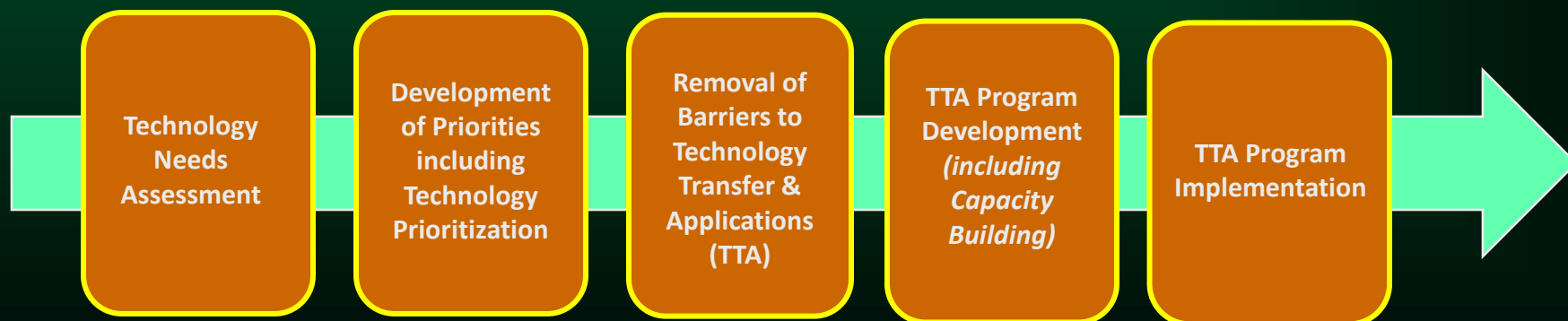

- ❑ Assessment of technology application requirements and barriers
- ❑ Addressing technology application issues and removal of barriers
- ❑ Private-Public Partnerships in technology demonstration, transfer, deployment and commercialization

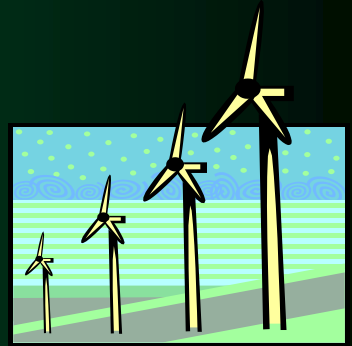
CCM & CCA Technology Transfer
